The basis material TermoSwed[®] is used by goods for all outdoor activities. TermoSwed[®] is unbeaten with regard to high physical impacts. The insulating property is excellent either regarding drought or wetness. If garments of TermoSwed[®] and cotton are wet through, both materials need the same time to dry. The only difference is the fact that a 50 % wet TermoSwed[®] piece of clothing has the same insulating property as dry piece of clothing made of cotton. If both pieces of clothing are dry TermoSwed[®] insulate 50 % better than cotton. TermoSwed[®] stands for optimal wetness transfer. The thin material and the extreme small stitches provide for a high carrying comfort and best insulation at low temperatures. Suitable for missions within +10° C to -15° C at best.

TIP: Wear a TermoSwed[®] tactical hood in the sleeping bag at night, as a high percentage of the body heat will be lost by the head.
